What you need to cover/criteria

- Your test will be out of 35 marks and must cover the 5 areas we have spent time on:
 - “Alive after Five” presentation
 - Employer/Employee Rights and Responsibilities
 - Workplace Injury
 - Hazard Recognition
 - Personal Protective Equipment (P.P.E.)

Types of Questions:

- You may choose to use:
 - Multiple choice
 - Fill-in-the-blanks
 - Short answer
 - Diagram
 - Chart (point-form info)
 - Essay (if you are feeling crazy)

Breakdown of questions: things to consider!

- How many questions will you assign to each topic?
- How much is each question worth? (needs to total 35 marks in total)
- What details would you be looking for?
- Why is the question important to ask?
